## General Information

Berlin is the capital of the Federal Republic of Germany. Covering an area of 891.82 km<sup>2</sup>, it is also the country's largest city with a population of 3.4 million. It is an influential center of culture, politics and science, a major tourist center and home to people from over 180 nations.

## Berlin public transport

Berlin has an extensive public transport system, consisting of S-Bahn (a mostly overground urban railway system), U-Bahn (mainly underground rail system), busses and trams. All of these can be accessed with the same ticket, available from counters or ticket machines at the S- and U-Bahn stations or directly from the bus drivers. Different kinds of day passes and group tickets are also available. All three main airports and all train stations are easily accessible by public transport.

## Reaching the congress venue by public transport

The Charité Campus Virchow Klinikum can be reached by bus, tram, U- and S-Bahn. Take the bus 221 or 106 or the U-Bahn line 9 to the station Amrumer Straße.

If you use the trams M13 or 50 to stop at Virchow Klinikum, please use the entrance Seestraße. The nearest S-Bahn station is Westhafen on the S-Bahn line 9. Please find route maps in the internet at <http://www.esbra2007.com/venue.html>

## Currency

The unit of currency is the Euro (€), divided into 100 cents. ATMs and exchange bureaux are widely available. The major credit cards are becoming more widely accepted in many large shops, hotels and restaurants, although Germans themselves prefer to carry cash.

Travellers cheques are best cashed at exchange bureaux, as banks often won't change them. The quickest and most convenient way to change money is to obtain cash from one of the ATM machines that are ubiquitous features of all German streets.

Banks are closed on weekends, but exchange bureaux at airports and main railway stations are open daily from 6am to 10pm.

### Passports and Visas

Citizens of European Union (EU) member states only need a valid identity card or passport and do not require visas.

US citizens in possession of a valid US passport do not need a visa (for stays up to 90 days). The passport must not expire before the end of the scheduled trip.

Participants from other countries should consult the nearest German consulate for more information.

### Time

Central European Time (GMT + 1); from 25/03/07 to 28/10/07  
Daylight Saving Time (GMT + 2).

### Closing times

Shops in the main touristic areas are usually open until 20.00

Monday to Saturday and closed on Sunday.

Most museums are closed on Monday.

There is no compulsory closing time for pubs.

### Electricity

220 volts, 50Hz. European-style two-pin plugs are standard.

### Telephone

The international access code for Germany is +49. The outgoing code is 00 followed by the relevant country code (e.g. 0044 for the United Kingdom). Note that telephone numbers in Germany can range from four to nine digits.

There are surcharges on international calls made from hotels; it is often cheaper to use public telephone boxes in post offices, which use phone cards. The local mobile phone operators use GSM networks and have roaming agreements with most international operators.

Local emergency telephone numbers are 112 (fire and ambulance) and 110 (police).
